
Replacement Parts Search Helpful Tips


HOW TO ACCESS PARTS PAGES & REPLACEMENT PART INFORMATION:

On the Service Documentation page within lincolnelectric.com, click the Replacement Parts Search tab.




SEARCHING FOR A PARTS PAGE BY CODE NUMBER:

If you know the machine code number, then type that into the main search box and click the magnifying glass icon.





Click the matching search result to open the parts page.




SEARCHING FOR A PARTS PAGE BY BROWSING/VISUAL SEARCH:

Navigate to the correct equipment type by using the product images and model names.









GENERAL SEARCH FOR A PART:

To perform a broad search, type the part number, part name, or any other descriptor in the search box. To filter the results to see where the part is used on a parts page, select the Type (Any) drop-down and select Books. Then, in the Categories (Any) drop-down, select Parts Pages.



SEARCHING FOR A PART WITHIN A PARTS PAGE:


Once in the parts pages for a given code, expand the table of contents tab by clicking the red 123 icon in the upper left. In the text search box, type the part number or description to be searched and then click the magnifying glass.



The left table of contents pane will first highlight which sub-assembly contains the part, and the parts list pane on the right will highlight the actual part in the parts list. To see all of the matches of the search results, continue to click the right arrow icon in the left pane.

PRINTING A PARTS PAGE:

Once in a parts page, select Export in the upper right. You can then select the entire parts page or a specific sub-assembly to print. To do this, under Section select the radial button next to Book (for the entire parts page) or next to Illustration (to print the current sub-assembly). Other formatting options, like page layout, can be modified here as well. Once all formatting options are selected, click Submit to start the export.



After several seconds, you will see the book available in the Job Manager. This file can then be opened and saved as needed.
